WELCOME TO THE 2025 SEASON OF AUSTRALIA'S PREMIER ONE-MAKE CHAMPIONSHIP, PORSCHE PAYNTER DIXON CARRERA CUP AUSTRALIA.

AN EIGHT-round 2025 Porsche Paynter Dixon Carrera Cup Australia Championship will see Australia's top one-make category return to iconic circuits new and old next year.

As well as maintaining a presence at Australia's largest motorsport events, Carrera Cup will also compete at some of Australia's best permanent circuits in a well-balanced 2025 schedule.

Carrera Cup will retain its position as the premier support category on the Repco Supercars Championship program in 2025 with every round hosted at major Supercars events and broadcast live on Fox Sports and Kayo, with selected key rounds also broadcast on the Seven Network.

The championship opens at Sydney Motorsport Park in late February at the Sydney 500, alongside the opening round of the Repco Supercars Championship.

The annual visit to the Formula 1 Australian Grand Prix will serve as round two, before the Top End hosts Round 3 of the championship in mid-June at Hidden Valley.

Round 4 will see the championship return to Queensland Raceway in Ipswich for the first time since the 2008 season.

The circuit was a staple on the Carrera Cup calendar between 2003-2008, with Jim Richards, Alex Davison, Fabian Coulthard and Craig Baird (twice) claiming round honours.

The circuit has provided exciting action in recent Porsche Michelin Sprint Challenge Australia rounds with the same expected when Carrera Cup returns.

Shell V-Power Motorsport Park at The Bend returns to host the fifth round; Carrera Cup continuing to support the opening round of the Supercars Endurance Season at The Bend 500.

The blockbuster run to the checkered flag then includes the regular stops at the Repco Bathurst 1000, Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500 and VAILO Adelaide Grand Finale to end the year on a high in South Australia.

Along with (schedule dependent) 60 minutes of practice and qualifying, Three races will feature at each round, with the Pro, Pro-Am, Michelin Junior, Endurance Cup (Pro & Pro-Am) and Teams Championships all offering title opportunities throughout the season.

The championship enjoys pride of place in the Supercars Championship paddock, the iconic Porsche Teams Hospitality Lounge, dedicated video, PR and digital media coverage plus the traditional support of the Porsche Motorsport Australia team – including the provision of spare parts, garaging, technical and operational support and much more.

2025 is going to be an enormous year for Australia's top one-make category!

The Porsche Motorsport Truck travels to each Carrera Cup Australia and provides spare parts support to those racing in the Series.

Porsche's Parts Sales Specialist is also on hand to provide quality and efficient service during race events, ensuring every car can source the required parts to return to the circuit and reducing the parts inventory each team is required to stock at events.

VIDEO CONTENT

Post race interviews, news and announcements captured at every round by a dedicated video team, with a strong focus on behind-the-scenes stories and in-depth profiles on drivers, teams and partners. The breadth of content also covers those support initiatives that distinguish the Series from other series in Australia.

PRESS RELEASES & MEDIA COVERAGE

Press releases are produced by the Porsche Motorsport communications team throughout the season and disseminated to Australian motoring and motorsport media before during and after each round, with support given to drivers and teams around season announcements and team/driver news. Despite Covid-related interruptions over the last two seasons, ASR media value has increased from \$2.6M in 2019 to in excess of \$7.32M in 2022 for Porsche Carrera Cup Australia content.

TEAMS LOUNGE

The Porsche Motorsport Australia Teams Lounge is constructed at every round to provide a premium experience for your team — both for catering purposes and as a place where guests, sponsors and VIPs can escape the paddock and relax, grab a coffee and chat — or watch the racing on TV. The impressive structure takes pride of place in the paddock at each round and includes catering for breakfast and lunch, a full-time Barista service, cold drinks and much more.

Porsche Motorsport Australia offers a dedicated professional photographic service at every round providing a high resolution folder of images after every day. Drivers can access the image via a Dropbox link which is sent directly to them prior to each event. As part of this service, all Carrera Cup drivers and teams have access to all images taken throughout the series free-of-charge for any non-commercial use – editorial, press releases, social media posts.

The Porsche Motorsport Australia team provides an on-site signwriting service to ensure your car is presented at its best at every round – whether it's adding a last-minute sponsor sticker or putting colour back on the car after some damage has been repaired, our on-site team will ensure you're looking good.

Porsche Motorsport Australia engages a dedicated driving standards advocate for the category, who works closely with the Race Director provided by Motorsport Australia to ensure our races proceed smoothly.
